Salvation is Trusting . .

.. the Person. Trusting the Person, Jesus Christ. Jesus is God. He came into this world to die. His death and shed blood on the Cross paid the price for my sin and for the sins of all who believe, trust and follow Him (Ephesians 1:7).

. . in the Provision. Trusting that the shed blood of Jesus Christ is the saving provision for my soul. Jesus took my place in judgment and crushed the head of the serpent (1 Peter 1:18-20).

. . in the Promise. Trusting that the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ sealed a promise from God that He will raise me from the dead and bring me to Himself for all eternity.

Romans 5:6,8,10
For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled we shall be saved by His life.

These truths are made real for us by the Holy Spirit through hearing and / or reading God's Words in the Bible. We then believe these truths and acquire them for ourselves by faith (Ephesians 2:1-5).

Jesus Christ is the only God-accepted Provision for Forgiveness of Sin and Salvation of the Soul (Acts 4:12).

Repentance and Discipleship declare the authenticity of God's Salvation work accomplished in a life. God does not grant Salvation to the unrepentant heart that has failed to acknowledge the right of Jesus Christ to rule all of his life. The individual who is saved is one who cedes total control of his life to Jesus Christ becoming His disciple (Matthew. 16:24-26).

The individual who has entered into a saving relationship with God declares that his self-centered way is all wrong [repentance] and turns to follow Jesus in the way He leads and empowers. This leading and power comes through the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:37-37).

Repentance and Discipleship are about yielding up all pride and possessions (Matthew 6:24).

It is recognizing that, before God, I have achieved nothing that is of merit or value in terms of salvation. This recognition declares that I can hold on to nothing in this world that is temporal and passing away (Isaiah 64:6-9).

The Cost of Discipleship (Luke 14:25,27,33)

Now great crowds accompanied Him, and He turned and said to them Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple. So therefore, any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be My disciple.

Salvation is the recognition of my Sin coupled with the desire to turn away from my former way of living, and asking the Lord Jesus to take complete control of my life! (Ephesians 4:17-32).

Rejecting the discipleship requirements of Jesus means a rejection of Jesus Himself (John 12:42-50).

The choice is always between thinking more highly of oneself in self-righteous pride or in valuing earthly possessions above total abandonment to Jesus Christ (John 6:63-69).
