John 8:3-11

Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery. And when they had set her in the midst, they said to Him, "*Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act. Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say?*"

This they said, testing Him, that they might have something of which to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and wrote on the ground with His finger, as though He did not hear.

So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, "*He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first.*"

And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience, went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

And Jesus answered and said to him,  
"Simon, I have something to say to you."  
So he said, "Teacher, say it."

*"There was a certain creditor who had two debtors.  
One owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty.  
And when they had nothing with which to repay,  
he freely forgave them both. Tell Me,  
therefore, which of them  
will love him more?"*

Simon answered and said,

*"I suppose the one whom  
he forgave more."*

And He said to him,

*"You have rightly judged."*

## Which of them will love him more?

Then He turned to the woman and said to Simon,

*"Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave Me  
no water for My feet, but she has washed My feet with  
her tears and wiped them with the hair of her head.*

*You gave Me no kiss, but this woman has not ceased to kiss My

But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying,

*"Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation? And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong."*

Then he said to Jesus,

*"Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom."*

And Jesus said to him,

*"Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."*

There will be more joy in heaven

*. . over one sinner who repents.*

Luke 15:1-7

So Jesus spoke this parable to them, saying:

*"What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it?*

*And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing.*

*I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance."*

10. Covet. To desire what someone has, either possessions or place, makes me covetous.

Galatians 3:23-28

But before faith came,  
we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the faith  
which would afterward be revealed. Therefore the  
law was our tutor to bring us to Christ,  
that we might be justified by faith.

But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.

For you are all sons of God through faith in  
Christ Jesus. For as many of you as  
were baptized into Christ  
have put on Christ.

There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is  
neither slave nor free, there is neither  
male nor female; for you are  
all one in Christ Jesus.

. . having forgiven you of all trespasses,  
*. . having nailed it to the cross.*

And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision  
of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him,

having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped

out the handwriting of requirements that was  
against us, which was contrary to us.

And He has taken it out of the way,  
having nailed it to the cross.

is in Christ,  
he is a new creation;  
old things have passed away;  
behold, all things have become new.

*I now understand that everything belongs to You for Your control and not for my control.*

*I have rebelled against Your will and have chosen to take my own way to my hurt and to the hurt of those around me.*

*I solemnly choose to let go of everything in my life and give all completely to You, the rightful Sovereign Owner.*

My Prayer, expressing my desire to say “Yes”

*. . .to Jesus calling me to Him!*

*Would You please draw me now to Yourself,  
forgive me and give me Your life?*

*Please send the Holy Spirit to give me the promised new birth  
and seal me as Your child and as Your very own  
purchased possession for all eternity.*

*Please give me Your supernatural joy and peace which  
You promised and that confirms that You  
have accepted my plea.*

*Dear Lord and Savior, I have counted the cost,  
knowing this requires all of me forever.*

*I am so very thankful that You are always pleased to receive  
and accept any and every person that comes to You  
on these terms of absolute surrender of self.”*

Luke 13:23,24

Then one said to Jesus,

*“Lord, are there few who are saved?”*

And He said to them,

*“Strive to enter through  
the narrow gate,  
for many,  
I say to you,  
will seek to enter  
and will not be able.”*

Will you now trust in Jesus Christ

*. . and what He did for you?*

Acts 4:12

*“Nor is there salvation in any other,*

*for there is no other name [Jesus Christ]  
under heaven given among men by which*

*we must be saved.”*

. . *Was it for me?*

When you have heard God's voice asking as He asked Adam, "*Where are you?*" (Genesis 3:9); when you have been arrested by your conscience and have been convicted by God, the Holy Spirit (John 16:8), of your sin, this page is your declaration of that event.

When God has spoken to you and you have asked Jesus Christ to be the Savior and Lord of your life, you will feel compelled to make it known (Romans 10:9).

Salvation is a Private Event occurring in the heart and no one except you and God can confirm it has happened (cf. Mark 4:13-20).

Even though salvation is a Private Event, being a follower of Christ requires a Public Profession. Jesus makes no option available to His followers to be undercover Christians (Romans 10:9).

*"So everyone who acknowledges Me before men, I also will acknowledge before My Father who is in heaven, but whoever denies Me before men, I also will deny before My Father who is in heaven"* (Matthew 10:32).

When you have heard God's voice,  
. . *tell somebody!*

Asking Jesus Christ to save you: [or similar words expressed by your own personality].

Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and my sin separates me from God. Because God, the Father, loves me, He sent You to pay the penalty for my sin by dying on the cross to restore me to fellowship with Himself (1 John 1:9).

I ask you to forgive my sins and give me eternal life (Luke 11:13).
