## Tracing the Scarlet Thread,

. . through human history.

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1. The Creation. Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Psalm 24:1 The earth is the Lord's and all it contains; the world, and those who dwell in it

2. The Commandment. As sovereign ruler, God decreed:

Genesis 2:17 The Lord God commanded the man, saying, "...but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

> 3. The Choice. Man will choose either to obey or to disobey God's sovereign authority and commands.

> > Psalm 14:1 The fool has said in his heart, *"There is no God."*

Have you eaten from the tree,

. . that I commanded you not to eat?

4. The Crime. Adam & Eve chose to disobey God and broke the one and only law in existence. Their crime brought fear + death to all their descendants.

Genesis 3:9-11 The Lord God called to Adam, "Where are you?" Adam said. "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."

And God said, "Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?"

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5. The Conviction.

Guilty! Sin always produces death.

Death now entered the world and the earth is cursed.

Genesis 3:17

"Because you . . have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you saying, 'You shall not eat of it"

## The Soul who sins,

. . shall die .)

6. The Confirmation of Sentence.

#### Ezekiel 18:20

. . the soul who sins shall die

The spirit died [access to God severed] immediately and the body died at a future date.

Holy God, the perfect just Judge, imposed the death sentence that perfect justice demanded, but, at the same time, Holy God, the Perfect Compassionate Judge, issued a stay of part of the sentence.

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Terms of a conditional Pardon are offered.

7. The Conditional Pardon.

Death of the physical body is still required, but a pardon from the penalty of eternal death of the soul, the separation from God forever, is conditionally offered to the convicted criminals and to their descendants who will receive the Terms of the Pardon.

Without the shedding of blood,

. . there is no forgiveness of sin.

Terms of the Pardon:

Saving faith in the life, death + resurrection of Jesus Christ, God's Son.

Hebrews 9:22

. . and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness (of sin)

Leviticus 17:11

. . for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul

Romans 5:9

. . having been justified by Christ's blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him

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The Scarlet Thread begins:

8. The Covering. God illustrated the horror of sin, which always results in death, by a sacrifice of an innocent life.

Genesis 3:21

Also for Adam and his wife the Lord God made tunics of skin, and clothed them.

The Scarlet Thread, one innocent animal dies, . . for the sin of one person.

Genesis 3:8-13

And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

> Then the Lord God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?"

So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."


And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?"

Then the man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate."

And the Lord God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?"

The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

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9. The Passover Lamb.

Exodus 12:3-13

Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household. And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take it according to the number of the persons; according to each man's need you shall make your count for the lamb.

Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats. Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight. And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.

> Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs they shall eat it. Do not eat it raw, nor boiled at all with water, but roasted in fire—its head with its legs and its entrails. You shall let none of it remain until morning, and what remains of it until morning you shall burn with fire.

## The Scarlet Thread, one lamb dies,

. . for the sins of the household.

And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. It is the Lord's Passover.

For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord.

Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

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An Annual Atonement

10. The Day of Atonement Goat & the Scapegoat. Leviticus 16:15–19,34

Then he shall kill the goat of the sin offering, which is for the people, bring its blood inside the veil, do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and before the mercy seat.

## The Scarlet Thread, one animal dies,

. . for the sins of the entire nation.

So he shall make atonement for the Holy Place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions, for all their sins; and so he shall do for the tabernacle of meeting which remains among them in the midst of their uncleanness.

> And he shall go out to the altar that is before the Lord, and make atonement for it, and shall take some of the blood of the bull and some of the blood of the goat, and put it on the horns of the altar all around. Then he shall sprinkle some of the blood on it with his finger seven times, cleanse it, and consecrate it from the uncleanness of the children of Israel.

This shall be an everlasting statute for you, to make atonement for the children of Israel.

for all their sins, once a year.

And he did as the Lord commanded Moses.

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The Scarlet Thread . . . Completed. The One Perfect Lamb for the World

11. Perfect Lamb of God. Jesus Christ became the one lamb who died one time sufficient for the whole world.

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29).

12. Perfect Love Displayed. Jesus voluntarily submitted to being killed to give His life as a sacrifice for the sin of the entire world.

He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so He opened not His mouth (Isaiah 53:7).

While we were still sinners, Christ,

. . the Lamb of God, died for us!

13. Perfect Punishment Paid. Jesus died on the cross at Calvary to fulfill the requirement that "the soul who sins shall die." (Ezekiel 18:20)His death was counted by God as the one acceptable substitute for all those who trust in him.

For God made Jesus who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Corinthians 5:21).

14. Perfect Substitute. Christ died in our place as our substitute.

For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. . . . but God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him (Romans 5:6-9).

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The Great White Throne Judgment

Revelation 20:11-12

Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them.

And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened,

which is the

Book of Life.

And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.

## Anyone not found written in the,

. . Book of Life . .

Those in Christ are born twice, but only die once. Those who die outside of Christ, are only born once, but must die twice.

Revelation 20:13-15

The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.

Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire.

This is the second death.

And anyone not found written in the

Book of Life

was cast into the lake of fire.

- 10. Covet. To ever desire what someone else possesses makes me covetous.

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Galatians 3:23-28

. . and what He did for you?


Acts 4:12
