The Crime:

"Where are you?"

Only one Law existed,

.. Adam & Eve violate it.

And He said, *"Who told you that you were naked?
Have you eaten from the tree of which
I commanded you that you should not eat?"*

Then the man said,
*"The woman whom You gave to be with me,
she gave me of the tree, and I ate."*

And the Lord God said to the woman,
"What is this you have done?"

The woman said,
"The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

CREATION

Genesis 1:1

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 1:31

Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good.

SIN

Genesis 3:9-11

Then the Lord God called to Adam and said to him, "*Where are you?*"

So he said, "*I heard Your voice in the garden, and was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself.*"

And He said, "*Who told you that you were naked?*"

Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?"

WRATH

John 3:36

He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

CHRIST

Acts 4:12

And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name [Jesus Christ] under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

The Road back to Heaven,

. . *Six Critical Direction Signs.*

CALVARY

Mark 15:34

And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "*Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?*" which is translated, "*My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?*"

John 19:30

So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "*It is finished!*" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

RESURRECTION = Historical fact, witnessed, recorded, verified and authenticated.

1 Corinthians 15:3-8

Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve.

After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present but some have fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

The Moral Law of God: Exodus 20:3-17

And God spoke all these words, saying:

1. "You shall have no other gods before Me.
2. "You shall not make for yourself a carved image
— any likeness of anything
3. "You shall not take the
name of the Lord your God in vain,
for the Lord will not hold him guiltless
who takes His name in vain.
4. "Remember the Sabbath day
5. "Honor your father and your mother
6. "You shall not murder.
7. "You shall not commit adultery.
8. "You shall not steal.
9. "You shall not bear false witness
against your neighbor.
10. "You shall not covet

James 2:10

For whoever shall keep the whole law,
and yet stumble in one point,
he is guilty of all.

Only sinners need a Savior!

Ezekiel 18:20 The soul who sins shall die.

The Courtroom,

. . the books are opened.

The Courtroom:
The books are opened and sentence announced.

Judgment at the Throne of God
Revelation 20:11-15

Then I saw a great white throne and Him who was seated on it.
From His presence earth and sky fled away, and
no place was found for them.

And I saw the dead, great and small,
standing before the throne, and
books were opened.

Then another book was opened,
which is the Book of Life.

In Heaven the,

. . books are opened.

And the dead were judged by what was written in the books,

**The Death and Shed Blood of a
Substitute will be Accepted**

Leviticus 17:11
For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and
I have given it for you on the altar to make
atonement for your souls,
for it is the blood
that makes atonement for the soul.

Is there no

. . hope?

**No Forgiveness or Pardon
without Shed Blood**

Hebrews 9:22

And according to the Law,
one may almost say,

all things are cleansed with blood, and
without shedding of blood there is
no forgiveness.

We need an

Advocate / Substitute,

.. we are unable to

pay our debt.

. . *Was it for me?*

Jesus Christ, the righteous . . *our Advocate.*

1 John 2:1,2

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin.

But if anyone does sin,
we have an advocate with the Father,
Jesus Christ the righteous.

He is the propitiation for our sins, and
not for ours only but also for the sins
of the whole world.

The Father forgives, . . *upon these terms.*

1 John 1:1-4,8-10

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning the Word of life— the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us—

that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. And these things we write to you that your joy may be full.

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

Terms of the Pardon,

. . *confession + trust in Jesus alone.*

Christ in Our Place
Romans 5:6-11

For when we were still without strength, in
due time Christ died for the ungodly.

For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps
for a good man someone would even dare to die.

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that
while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Much more then, having now been justified by His blood,
we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God
through the death of His Son, much more, having been
reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through
our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have
now received the reconciliation.

If you . .

Confession + Belief = Salvation
Romans 10:9-11

If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe
in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead,
you will be saved.

For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and
with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

For the Scripture says,

“Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.”

The Prize,

.. Heaven forever.

Romans 8:1-3

Therefore there is now no condemnation
for those who are in Christ Jesus.

No Condemnation,

. . guaranteed.

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus

from the law of sin and of death.

For what the Law could not do
weak as it was through the flesh

God did:

sending His own Son in the likeness of
sinful flesh and as an offering for sin,

He condemned sin in the flesh

There will be no weeping for those who,
. . trust in Jesus Christ.

“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father’s hand.

. . those who trust Him.

1. JESUS is GOD.

1 Timothy 3:16

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness:
God was manifested in the flesh, justified in the Spirit,
seen by angels, preached among the Gentiles,
believed on in the world,
received up in glory.

2. ALL SCRIPTURE, in the original languages, is GOD
inspired and nothing can be discarded.

2 Timothy 3:16

All Scripture is given by inspiration of
God, for reproof, for correction, and
is profitable for doctrine,
for instruction in
righteousness.

1. Jesus is God
2. All Scripture is Inspired

Saving Faith in Jesus Holds These Four Truths:

3. Jesus is Lord and all - sufficient Savior
[Saved by Grace, it is the gift of God, not of our works]
4. Jesus is the only Way to God, the Father

3. JESUS CHRIST is LORD and
requires ALL of one's life
to be given to HIM.

You are not your own, for you

4. JESUS CHRIST is the Only Way. JESUS CHRIST alone, by Faith alone.

I now understand that everything belongs to You for Your control and not for my control.

I have rebelled against Your will and have chosen to take my own way to my hurt and to the hurt of those around me.

I solemnly choose to let go of everything in my life and give all completely to You, the rightful Sovereign Owner.

My Prayer, expressing my desire to say “Yes”

. . .to Jesus calling me to Him!

*Would You please draw me now to Yourself,
forgive me and give me Your life?*

*Please send the Holy Spirit to give me the promised
new birth and seal me as Your very own
purchased possession for all eternity.*

*Please give me Your supernatural joy and peace which
You promised and that confirms that You
have accepted my plea.*

*Dear Lord and Savior, I have counted the cost,
knowing this requires all of me forever.*

*I am so very thankful that You are always pleased to receive
and accept any and every person that comes to You
on these terms of absolute surrender of self.”*

. . *Was it for me?*

Luke 13:23,24

Then one said to Jesus,

“Lord, are there few who are saved?”

And He said to them,

*“Strive to enter through
the narrow gate,
for many,
I say to you,
will seek to enter
and will not be able.”*

Will you now trust in Jesus Christ,

. . and what He did for you?

Acts 4:12

“Nor is there salvation in any other,

*for there is no other name [Jesus Christ]
under heaven given
among men
by which*

we must be saved.”

. . *Was it for me?*

When you have heard God's voice asking as He asked Adam, "*Where are you?*" (Genesis 3:9); when you have been arrested by your conscience and have been convicted by God, the Holy Spirit (John 16:8), of your sin, this page is your declaration of that event.

When God has spoken to you and you have asked Jesus Christ to be the Savior and Lord of your life, you will feel compelled to make it known (Romans 10:9).

Salvation is a Private Event occurring in the heart and no one except you and God can confirm it has happened (cf. Mark 4:13-20).

Even though salvation is a Private Event, being a follower of Christ requires a Public Profession. Jesus makes no option available to His followers to be undercover Christians (Romans 10:9).

"So everyone who acknowledges Me before men, I also will acknowledge before My Father who is in heaven, but whoever denies Me before men, I also will deny before My Father who is in heaven" (Matthew 10:32).

When you have heard God's voice,
. . *tell somebody!*

Asking Jesus Christ to save you: [or similar words expressed by your own personality].

Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and my sin separates me from God. Because God, the Father, loves me, He sent You to pay the penalty for my sin by dying on the cross to restore me to fellowship with Himself (1 John 1:9).

I ask you to forgive my sins and give me eternal life (Luke 11:13).

It is my deepest desire to love You and obey Your Words (Romans 10:9-10).
