

VI. Jesus Christ is who He declared Himself to be.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." John 14:6

VII. Jesus Christ is the only mediator between God and men.

This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all 1 Timothy 2:3-6

Salvation is found in no one,

VIII. Salvation is found in Jesus Christ alone.

Jesus Christ is "the stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone."

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved. Acts 4:11-12

IX. The Bible is God's mind in written form for man's instruction and encouragement.

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16,17

What is sin?

X. Sin. All men instinctively know in the deepest recesses of their emotional being that they have sinned against Holy God by disobeying His commands. Also, men know they have committed evil in that they have verbally, physically And emotionally harmed other people.

> All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way Isaiah 53:6

... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God ... Romans 3:23

What is worship?

XI. Worship. All men worship (profess allegiance). The object of man's worship will be either the one true God, or will be man, himself, who wants above all else to pursue his own will and to control his circumstances. When a man worships himself, he will make a god of "his own image" or conception. This false god can be material (a man-made image) or immaterial (a philosophy or theory) such as hedonism [pursue pleasure and flee pain], or evolution [denying God as the Creator], or a political system, or a religious system, etc.

This worship is the foundation upon which all men make their life choices and pursuits.

[Men have] exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator. Romans 1:25

What happens after I die?

XII. Death. All men know they will die . . . what comes next?

And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment Hebrews 9:27

You do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away James 4:14

XIII. After Death. All men live by a faith which can be defined as their worldview. This worldview is based upon a belief of the existence or non-existence of sovereign God. If a man does not believe in a sovereign God, he [in his day-by-day living] illustrates that he must trust in annihilation after death . . . or, has faith in some unexplainable hope, that he will not have to stand before sovereign God and give an account of his life. This worldview, consciously or unconsciously, impacts every decision a man makes in his lifetime.

Annihilation is a faith and is based upon man's choice to practice a "head in the sand" approach to death and to the eternity that God has placed in his heart. Annihilation is a foolish philosophy that temporarily attempts to silence the conscience and allows man to be able to reject the sobering thought of standing in judgement before sovereign God.

Eternity = an unknowable future of endless time.

God has put eternity in their hearts. Ecclesiastes 3:11

If the dead are not raised, "Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die." 1 Corinthians 15:32

Will men face judgment after death?

XIV. Judgment. All men, having been given a conscience, inwardly understand that the universe must be a moral place and that all sin, including their own, must face judgment.

I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened.

And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. Revelation 20:12

After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present but some have fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.



When you have heard God's voice asking as He asked Adam, "Where are you?" (Genesis 3:9); when you have been arrested by your conscience and have been convicted by God, the Holy Spirit (John 16:8), of your sin, this page is your declaration of that event.

> When God has spoken to you and you have asked Jesus Christ to be the Savior and Lord of your life, you will feel compelled to make it known (Romans 10:9).

> > Salvation is a private event occurring in the heart and no one except you and God can confirm it has happened (cf. Mark 4:13-20).

Even though salvation is a private event, being a follower of Christ requires a public profession. Jesus makes no option available to His followers to be undercover Christians (Romans 10:9).

"So everyone who acknowledges Me before men, I also will acknowledge before My Father who is in heaven, but whoever denies Me before men, I also will deny before My Father who is in heaven" (Matthew 10:32).

When you have heard God's voice,

. . tell somebody!

Asking Jesus Christ to save you: [or similar words expressed by your own personality].

Lord Jesus, I know I am a sinner, and my sin separates me from God. Because God, the Father, loves me, He sent You to pay the penalty for my sin by dying on the cross to restore me to fellowship with Himself (1 John 1:9).

I ask you to forgive my sins and give me eternal life (Luke 11:13).
