1. According to John 1:1-14, who created all things?
2. How are "words" described or characterized in this passage?
3. What is the implication of the word "NEED" in a spiritual context?
4. What characteristics of God are said to be present in humanity, as we are made in His image?
5. Based on the provided text, does the truth that all people are born with some characteristics of God's image enable Christians to love their neighbors without prejudice?
6. According to the supporting verses in Colossians 1:15-18, did the Man Jesus create the world, or was it the Eternal Word, the Spirit of Jesus?
7. When did the Spirit of Jesus, as God the Son, "put on flesh" and enter the womb of the Virgin Mary?
8. What is the significance of Jesus having a birthday, distinct from the Eternal Word/Spirit, which has no beginning or end?
9. What is Jesus's current state and form in heaven?
10. Why did God, the Eternal Spirit/Word, become a man?
