

## Gospel of John

### Study Questions for Chapter 13:

1. **Why** did God inspire John to write about the events in this chapter, since the other Gospels don't mention them?
2. Jesus died during the Passover. What important event from the Old Testament book of **Exodus** does the Passover represent?
3. When Jesus washed the disciples' feet, He was the Lord and Teacher doing a servant's job. What was the **main lesson** He was teaching about true greatness?
4. Peter didn't want Jesus to wash his feet, but Jesus said Peter couldn't be connected to Him unless He did. What did Jesus's act of washing the feet **symbolically mean** in this moment?
5. Jesus said a "bathed" person only needs their "feet" washed. What does being "**bathed**" mean for a Christian, and what does the "**feet washing**" represent for daily life?
6. How did Jesus secretly show John which disciple would **betray** Him, and why didn't the other disciples realize what Jesus was doing?
7. What spirit **entered** Judas immediately after he received the bread from Jesus, and what short instruction did Jesus give Judas?
8. What is the "**new commandment**" Jesus gave to His followers, and what should this command show to the rest of the world?
9. What was the difference between **Judas's sin** (betrayal) and **Peter's sin** (denial)?
10. The disciples called Jesus both "**Teacher**" and "**Lord.**" If we call Him both today, what action (or attitude) must we follow according to His example in this chapter?
