### Study Questions for Chapter 20:

1. How many hours did Jesus remain on the cross before He died, and why was the Roman governor surprised by this?
2. How was Jesus' body prepared for the tomb, and what happened to the spices and linen as they sat for three days?
3. What was unique about the way Jesus left the grave cloths (the "linen mold") that proved He hadn't been moved by human hands?
4. When Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene, what was the specific word He spoke that caused her to recognize Him?
5. Where does the text suggest Jesus was (in "Paradise") between His death and His resurrection?
6. What was the "triumphal entry" into the Father's house that Jesus was preparing for when He told Mary not to cling to Him?
7. What are two examples from the text of Jesus defying the laws of physics after He rose?
8. What did Jesus do in front of the disciples (specifically involving food and His wounds) to prove He was a real, tangible person and not a ghost?
9. In what specific way did Jesus say He was sending the disciples out into the world?
10. What did Jesus say to Thomas that proved He had been a "silent listener" to Thomas's private doubts earlier that week?
