3. Between the events of John, Chapter 5 and Chapter 6, what significant event occurred that caused Jesus sadness and a need for solitude?
4. Why did a great multitude follow Jesus across the Sea of Galilee?
5. What was Jesus's initial intention when he went up on a mountain with his disciples?
6. How does the mention of the Passover feast being near provide context for the events in this chapter?
7. Where did the events of Chapter 5 take place, and where did Jesus move to before the events of Chapter 6?
8. Why did Jesus move from Jerusalem to Galilee?
9. In what way did the multitude's actions following Jesus by land after he had departed by ship thwart his desire for solitude?
10. What does the feeding of the 5,000 signify about Jesus?
