- **The Women:** Mary (Mother of Jesus) & Elizabeth.
- **Scripture:** Luke 1:5-56.
- **The Deep Dive:** Analysis of the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy through the lineage of Aaron (Elizabeth) and David (Mary). A study of the "Magnificat" as a theological summary of God's sovereignty.

 5. What specific Old Testament themes are echoed in the Magnificat?
 6. How did the Holy Spirit affirm the identity of Jesus through Elizabeth's greeting?
 7. For how many months did Mary stay with Elizabeth?
 8. Identify the three attributes of God highlighted in Mary's song.
 9. In what way does Mary's song address social and economic reversal?
 10. How does this passage demonstrate God's faithfulness to the covenant with Abraham?

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
